BAND DIRECTOR'S MARSHALING INFORMATION

Grand Floral Parade starts at 1:00 p.m.

REGISTRATION AND MARSHALING AREA

Band marshaling personnel will be available at band registration check in point at Hoyt and Court Streets. The Parade Coordinator determines the arrival time of each Band. There is a five minute interval between each band. Please keep band members in immediate area and be ready to step off at their designated time.

ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE: Cars, vans, trailers, go carts or equipment trucks are not permitted to follow the band. No sirens or air horns, public address systems or use of amplification equipment are allowed. No objects of any kind may be distributed or thrown to spectators from band directors, band members or chaperons.

For every 30 band members ONE chaperone is sufficient. Band directors and chaperones should be dressed similar style attire that identifies them as part of the band. Parade personnel will monitor the number of chaperones.

Bands must keep 75 feet from the unit ahead of them at all times. There will be no stopping to perform at any time. All special acts or movements will be performed while moving forward at a speed necessary to maintain the 75 feet intervals.

Reviewing stand and television.... the **BAND PLAY NOW** signs will allow you ample time to start playing. No stopping, performing or counter marching will be permitted unless directed by the Parade marshal. Bands must not stop their forward motion in order to perform.

RELEASE POINT AND DEMARSHALING AREA

The Parade route continues on Main Street in Benton Harbor to 6th Street, right on 6th Street to Wall Street, this is the release point at which time the band is to cease playing. Continue to walk to the refreshment area. Band buses will be staged in the parking lot between Wall and Oak Streets. At this point there will be an emergency vehicle, if needed and portable restrooms.

BUS DRIVER INFORMATION

The Parade Coordinator determines the arrival time of each band. There is a five minute interval between each band. Band buses are to turn right off of Niles Avenue on to Hoyt Street. Band marshaling personnel will be available at the Band Registration check in point at Hoyt and Court Streets.


All bands must be in their assigned spots at the time designated on the Arrival Time Sheet. Buses must leave the unloading area no longer than fifteen minutes after unloading passengers, assuming weather conditions are favorable. Bus drivers should check their bus to be sure all passengers have aborted, musical instruments and banners have been removed.


All band buses should proceed to Wall Street in Benton Harbor as directed on the enclosed map. All buses leaving the unloading area will follow the route highlighted on the map and proceed to the band parking lot in Benton Harbor, via Pearl Street to Langley Avenue to Napier, then left on to Colfax, to band bus parking lot.




